Major/Minor project proposal in Digital Humanities and Environmental Humanities

We are looking for cutting edge research proposals to address questions at the intersections of Technology and the Humanities. These may include but are not limited to AI for Language & Translation, NLP(Natural Language Processing), Scholarly Publishing, Open Access, Spatial Humanities, Digital Cartography, Archiving and Digitization, Sustainability Studies, History of Environment, Planetary Justice and Rights, Environment in Civilization Studies, Governance in SDGs, Environmental Education and Literacy and related areas. Technologies/Proposals for teaching 'writing' may also be submitted as an outreach project.

Submitted proposals should include:

- 1. A five page proposal with abstract, objectives, methodology, deliverables, and a clear budget outline.
- 2. A short two page CV of the PI(s).

Major proposals between 7-10 lacs and minor proposals between 3-5 lacs will be selected for funding after a rigorous review and evaluation process by subject experts.

Who Can Participate?

Faculty from Research Institutes/institutes of national importance as defined by the Ministry of Education (MoE) / UGC recognized Indian universities / deemed universities under 12 B are eligible to apply. Other registered organizations with established research and academic standing may collaborate with any of the above mentioned institutions for implementation for the project as partners.

What are we looking for?

Originality, novelty, diversity, inclusiveness and clearly articulated Submitted as a single tangible outcome.
